Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Bahamian Government has issued requirements to help ensure your health and safety. These requirements must be strictly adhered to or you will be refused entry.

Currently there seems to be some confusion and conflicting information about what is required for entry to Bimini.

The Minister of Tourism and Aviation Dionisio D'Aguilar announced on June 17th that the government will require all individuals, including tourists, to **test negative** for the new coronavirus before traveling to The Bahamas **after July 1**. This requirement not been update on the Bahamas visitor website (<https://travel.gov.bs/international>) as of this writing.

Therefore, we are recommending that **all visitors obtain a COVID-19 test** and upload the negative test results with your application for a **Bahamas Travel Health Card** (see below). We also strongly recommend that you bring with you that test result along with your other necessary travel documents. We will not require a COVID-19 test as a requirement at the Marina, however Government requirements trumps the Marina.

Before you Arrive

Go to the Bahamas visitor website at <https://travel.gov.bs/international> to submit your application for a **Bahamas Travel Health Card**. Basic information about you and your travel as well as information regarding your health is required. If you have had a COVID-19 test (may be required), you will be asked to upload the test results. We strongly suggest that you printout your application **before** submitting the application and bring the copy along with your other travel documents to Bimini.

Make sure you bring plenty of PPE equipment (**masks covering mouth and nose**).

Upon Arrival

Bimini Bay Marina has applied with the Bahamian Government to become a “Clean and Pristine” facility for more information go to:

The mandatory requirements while on Marina property are as follows:

- Each person on the boat must wear a face mask while vessel is being tied up or disembarking.
- No physical contact with staff members (handshakes, hugging, etc.) is permitted.
- In order to check-in with Customs/Immigration and the Marina, only one designated person can leave the boat.
- The designated person will take care of dockage paperwork at the Marina office including making appropriate payment via credit card (Cash will not be accepted).
- Temperature screenings for all incoming visitors will be conducted by personnel.
- All persons on the boat must complete and sign the Consent of Liability Form (see attached).
- After check-in with Customs/Immigration and the Marina has been completed, the passengers and crew may disembark subject to the following conditions:
 - Face protection masks must be worn on Marina property at all times (this include on the docks and aboard the boat while docked).
 - Maintain a safe 6 ft distancing while on Marina property at all times (this include on the docks).
 - No social gatherings while on Marina property of more than 10 people at all times (this include on the docks and aboard the boat while docked).
 - Frequent hand washing or use of hand sanitizers is encouraged

The above is **MANDATORY**. If you and/or anyone in your party chooses to not meet these requirements, they will not be permitted to disembark and must leave the Marina immediately. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED IF YOU AND/OR ANYONE IN YOUR PARTY DOES NOT ADHERE TO ALL OF THE REQUIREMENTS.**

ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY RELATING TO CORONAVIRUS/COVID-19

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is reported to be extremely contagious. The state of medical knowledge is evolving, but the virus is believed to spread from person-to-person contact and/or by contact with contaminated surfaces and objects, and even possibly in the air. People reportedly can be infected and show no symptoms and therefore spread the disease. The exact methods of spread and contraction are unknown, and there is no known treatment, cure, or vaccine for COVID-19. Evidence has shown that COVID-19 can cause serious and potentially life-threatening illness and even death.

Bimini Bay Marina, Bimini Bay Resort Management, Ltd. and RAV Bahamas Limited (collectively, "Bimini Bay Marina") cannot prevent you or your child(ren) from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 while utilizing Bimini Bay Marina's services or premises. It is not possible to prevent against the presence of the disease. Therefore, if you choose to utilize Bimini Bay Marina's services and/or enter onto Bimini Bay Marina's premises you may be exposing yourself to and/or increasing your risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I have read and understood the above warning concerning COVID-19. I hereby voluntarily assume the risk of contracting COVID-19 for myself and/or my children in order to utilize Bimini Bay Marina's services and enter Bimini Bay Marina's premises. These services are of such value to me and/or to my children, that I accept the risk of being exposed to, contracting, and/or spreading COVID-19 in order to utilize Bimini Bay Marina's services and premises in person.

WAIVER OF LAWSUIT/LIABILITY: I hereby fully and irrevocably release and discharge Bimini Bay Marina and its owners, officers, directors, managers, officials, trustees, agents, employees, or other representatives from any claims, demands, suits, or actions which I have or may have had at any time in connection with exposure, infection, and/or spread of COVID-19 related to utilizing Bimini Bay Marina's services and premises. I understand that this waiver means I give up my right to bring any claims including for personal injuries, death, disease or property losses, or any other loss, including but not limited to claims of negligence and give up any claim I may have to seek damages, whether known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen.

I agree that I will not assert or maintain against Bimini Bay Marina any claim, action or demand of any kind or nature whatsoever in connection with or related to contracting COVID-19 by virtue of the utilization of Bimini Bay Marina's services or premises or any matter ancillary or relating thereto which was unknown, unaccrued or unanticipated at the time of the execution hereof.
